## THE POWER STATION (Phase 2) Reaching milestones and new heights

**This summer our construction managers Mace have reached two major milestones, with the completion of the first new apartments inside the Power Station and the steelwork inside the Boiler House reaching its highest point.**

The Chimney lift at the Power Station is underway, the glass elevator will travel 109 metres to the top of one of the iconic chimneys. Once completed, it will provide visitors a surreal view of the capital's skyline.

There has been excellent progress on the eastern side of the Power Station during the summer. This was marked by the removal of the tower crane from Turbine Hall B in August, which will allow the team to progress the detailed restoration of this historic space.



## The Electric Boulevard (Phase 3a) Super Structure

At the end of July our Phase 3a construction managers, Sir Robert McAlpine, completed the demolition of the temporary bridge on site. This landmark stage of the works allows the team to complete the basement works and progress with the building's superstructure.

Innovative hybrid diggers are being used for excavation works on site to help minimise carbon emissions by reducing fuel consumption and helping to improve air quality in the surrounding area.

The team continues to work with our supply chain to utilise sustainable timber sources, ensuring that timber is harvested responsibly from well-managed forests and minimises the impact on the environment.

## Phase 4a

Ground works have continued to progress over the summer period, with piling and excavation works taking place around the site between Thessaly Road and Sleaford Street.

This month our Phase 4a construction managers, Ardmore, will begin the installation of the first tower cranes on site, which will then be used to lift and move building materials as works progress.

Noise and vibration monitors are in place around the site to monitor the works and our contractors are aiming to minimise any potential disturbance to neighbouring residents.

The London Borough of Wandsworth has agreed that works can take place overnight around the Power Station between the hours of 8pm and 8am, including on Saturday and Sunday. Measures are in place to minimise disturbance to our neighbours and the Construction Managers frequently review planned louder works so that they can be carried out during general site working hours.
