

CREATE YOUR OWN EASTER BUNTING

Easter is almost upon us and what better way to get the family excited than to decorate the house with some crafty Easter bunting!

YOU WILL NEED

- A printer and something to colour in with such as crayons, paint, colouring in pencils or coloured card
- String
- Cellotape or glue
- Scissors
- Added extras: Cotton wool

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Choose if you would like to make bunting with bunnies or triangles.
2. If you have a printer, print your chosen template out and carefully cut around the outline to create your shape, making sure you include the tabs. If using coloured card, sketch the outline from the template onto a piece of card including the tabs, and cut it out to make a template. Then draw around the template onto more sheets or card, and cut these out. You will want between 5-10 bunnies or triangles depending on the length of space you intend to display the bunting.
3. Decorate your bunnies or triangles with paints, crayons or colouring in pencils. If you are making the bunnies, why not add cotton wool to give it a fluffy tail.
4. Gently fold the tabs using the dotted line as a guide, making sure it is folded away from the decorated side.
5. Cut your string to length, including some extra length to tie it up at each end.
6. Attach your bunnies or triangles onto the string by folding the tab over the string, and using a strip of cello tape on the tab to secure it to the back of the bunny or triangle
Helpful hint: To get even spacing use a ruler or another piece of string to measure the same distance each time.
